



KEEPSAKE MONOGRAMS v1.0

A unique font that lets you create custom 3-letter monograms in a distinctive style of adjoining script capitals with or without a choice of 10 decorative borders.

1. Install the font like any other. (Google: Install fonts in [my operating system].)
2. Relaunch the program you're working in. Now you're ready to make custom monograms.
3. Choose a border if desired and type it first, keystrokes in red.



4. Type a lowercase letter (a–z) for the left letter.
5. Type an uppercase letter (A–Z) for the center letter.
6. The right letter is a bit trickier. Use this chart to locate your letter on the standard keyboard.

After the right-hand letter is typed, the monogram is complete and the cursor will move to the right.
