MFC Brass Rules Petit Guidebook

The inspiration source for Brass Rules Petit is a collection of the brass rules from the 1889 "Convenient Book of Specimens" from Franklin Type Foundry in Cincinnati. This is a collection of basic utilitarian brass rules that has been created as combinable and endlessly expanding.

You can start with a new document or work on a new layer within an existing document. Select MFC Brass Rules Petit from the font menu. (Some users may have font previewing enabled in the font menu which will cause the font name to appear as line rule elements, disable this option in order to choose the name)

When typesetting with MFC Brass Rules Petit, you will want to change the line spacing or leading of the font to match or be less than the point size that you are typing in to minimize line gaps.
